SERIES 1000 - ADMINISTRATION

CHAPTER 1101 - VILLAGE TRUSTEES, VACANCIES IN OFFICE

THE VILLAGE OF LAKE LINDEN ORDAINS:

1. Election and Terms of Office. The election and term of office of a Village Trustee shall be as provided by law.
2. Filling Vacancies. A vacancy occurring in the office of Trustee shall be filled by appointment by the Council, and the appointee shall hold office until the next regular election.
3. Vacancy in Office. A vacancy in the office of Trustee shall be deemed to occur upon death, mental incapacity as determined by a proper Court, resignation, recall, or forfeiture of office resulting from:
 - (1) disqualification on grounds as provided by law;
 - (2) conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude; or,
 - (3) unexcused absences from three consecutive meetings of the Council.
4. Effective Date. This provision of the Code shall take effect upon publication as required by law. All other provisions in the Code in conflict are hereby repealed.

This provision of the Code was adopted on September 9th, 1993 by the Village Council.
